Music Lessons at School: Apply now for Academic Year 2023-24

Learning to play a musical instrument and developing musical skills is one of the most exciting things a young person can do. Not only is it fun and rewarding, but it has proven to help children develop:

- personal and social skills: self-confidence, teamwork
- perception, awareness, creativity and imagination
- language, numeracy and literacy skills
- · general attainment and intellectual development

Music lessons at our school are delivered by our chosen partner, Northamptonshire Music and Performing Arts Trust (NMPAT) - one of the leading Music Education Hubs in the country, with exceptional enrichment and progression opportunities.

NMPAT teachers provide tuition for a wide range of instruments, generally available to pupils in Key Stage 2, though recorders and violins may be suitable for some Year 2 pupils. NMPAT provide instrumental lessons for 33 weeks per academic year, over three 11-week teaching periods and, subject to student absences / school activity conflicts, will guarantee a minimum of 30 lessons throughout an academic year. The cost of lessons includes the loan of orchestral instruments free of charge. (This does not include guitars, keyboard or drum kits):

Option 1

NMPAT's standard tuition is provided as 15-minute lessons per child. This means that a productive amount of time can be spent with your child on a 1:1 basis or that two students of similar standard can combine for a 30-minute lesson.

The cost of these music lessons in 2023/24 is £130 per 11-week term.

Option 2

A Recorder Group will be run at our school again in 2023-24, if there is sufficient interest. These lessons will be at a cost of £43.00 per child / per 11 sessions of 30 minutes each for a group of 5-7 pupils, or 15 minutes for groups of 2-4.

Tuition fees are paid termly in advance direct to NMPAT, not the school. If, after your child starts their lessons, you wish to discontinue those lessons, you should give a minimum of five teaching weeks' notice, in writing, to NMPAT.

Full information relating to the teaching scheme provided by NMPAT can be seen in their <u>Terms</u> & Conditions.

Children on Pupil Premium can apply for bursary funding towards the cost of music tuition. Application should be made direct to the school and, if granted, we will inform NMPAT, who will invoice the school in respect of this contribution. You will then receive information from NMPAT about any payment remaining. Please ensure bursary applications are submitted as early as possible.

What to do next:

Please register your interest in music lessons for your child by logging in to https://presto.nmpat.co.uk/musicinschool. You will be asked to provide NMPAT with some basic details and indicate which instrument, from the choice available at our school, that your child is interested in learning.

If you do not have access to the internet, please complete and return the 'Expression of Interest' form which follows. This form should be returned to NMPAT and not the school.

NMPAT will register your interest and contact you to advise availability, with any recommendations for you to consider. You will not be making any commitment at this stage, but it will allow us to work together to provide the required lessons for next year.
