It would be helpful being told how to log onto the various platforms.	Sent out guidance in September about all the different websites (please email your child's class teacher if you would like another copy)

What support is being offered?	Made the Computing Hub available at lunch times so that the children can ask for help if needed. Of course, the children can also ask their class teacher for help too!

It would be helpful if passwords were set out clearly and what they are for.	Have developed a new system which will be available in September to make passwords easier for you at home.
That the rewards are not an incentive to complete Home Learning. The whole class should not be rewarded if they haven't completed the Home Learning.	Rewarded the children who have completed their Home Learning when their class is randomly selected each Friday.
A bit more variety.	Have made scooters available as well as an option of others sports to take part in during the session.
More rewards for individual achievements.	Have invited one child from each class that has shown exceptional efforts with their Home Learning this year, to have breakfast at 'The Hut' with myself and Mrs Warren this term. This will continue.
That you preferred it when the nuggets were counted on a Thursday as it gave your child more time to complete them.	Changed the admin process of monitoring the nuggets which are now counted after 7:30 am on a Friday (from the previous Saturday).
That an hour every evening of Home Learning is excessive .	Acknowledge your concerns and will adjusted our expectations from September.
